## Community Mental Wellness & Resilience Act of 2025 (H.R. 4744)

- Establishes a competitive CDC grant program to create, operate, or expand community-based initiatives using a public health approach to build mental wellness and resilience
- Strengthens communities' capacity to promote mental wellness and resilience and prevent or heal mental health challenges caused by disasters and toxic stress
- Includes a set-aside to address rural mental health disparities
- Supports communities in developing developmentally and culturally appropriate strategies to sustain population-level mental wellness, with particular focus on populations facing higher risk factors and barriers to care

## Resilience Investment, Support, & Expansion (RISE) from Trauma Act (H.R. 6625)

- Creates HHS grants for community-based coalitions to coordinate stakeholders and deliver local trauma prevention and response services
- Establishes HHS grants for hospital-based trauma interventions to address mental health needs, prevent re-injury, and improve long-term outcomes
- Increases funding for the National Health Service Corps loan repayment program to recruit more school-based mental health clinicians
- Enhances federal trauma-informed training programs at HHS, DOJ, and the Department of Education for early childhood clinicians, educators, first responders, and community leaders
- Reauthorizes four programs: Interagency Task Force on Trauma-Informed Care, National Child Traumatic Stress Network, CDC ACEs Data Collection program, and SAMHSA Trauma Support in Schools grants
