On behalf of the undersigned organizations, we write to thank you for your willingness to engage with stakeholders to address concerns raised regarding your bill, AB 762, which would have prohibited the manufacture and sale of integrated (“all-in-one”) cannabis vapor devices.

We appreciate your decision to amend the bill to remove cannabis vapor devices from its scope.

With this amendment, the issues that previously formed the basis of our opposition have been resolved. Accordingly, we respectfully **remove our opposition** to AB 762 and are now **Neutral** on the measure.
